The Director will use their gifts to care for the PCC family as well as embark on new ministry opportunities alongside the Pastor and church leaders. This will include leading and connecting volunteers and staff through worship, service, and growth.

- Work with the Pastor and church leaders to envision and implement new ministries that will impact
 existing students and families while also reaching out to our unchurched neighbors, Costa Mesa
 High School, and Orange Coast Community College.
 - Create multifaceted Family Ministries in partnership with the Pastor that includes music, new programming, service opportunities, and fellowship activities.
 - Develop/find age-appropriate curriculum that is engaging for children and students of diverse backgrounds (culturally, ethnically, and socio-economically) which nurture their faith in Jesus Christ.
 - Create a culture of supporting parents and other adults to become spiritual leaders sharing God's love and encouraging children, students and young adults in their growth and development.
- Develop robust and healthy volunteer teams.
 - o Recruit, equip, and empower volunteers from various backgrounds and life stages to maximize influence and reach.
 - o Build with the team an organized structure and plan for Family Ministries.
 - o Develop a culture of affirmation, celebration, and vision.
- Create a vibrant, dynamic, and safe environment for Family Ministries.
 - o Design an appealing space for youth and families.
 - o Establish and foster healthy lines of communication between Family Ministries and other ministries within the church.
 - Plan and execute Family Ministries programs and/or childcare for seasonal services and other events.
 - Ensure compliance with the PCC Child/Youth/Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy.
- Contribute to and participate in a healthy staff culture.
 - o Participate in staff meetings, as well as church events and activities.

- Perform other duties as situation requires or as assigned by the Pastor.
